Visit to the tropical dry forest and Jalisco coast

Area	Chamela and Jalisco Coast (Barra de Navidad, Chamela, Puerto Vallarta and Guadalajara)
Goals	Visiting three Long Term Ecological Research-MEX areas, learning on local conservation and resource management projects, and enjoying beautiful sites at the pacific coast
General Itinerary	4 days and 3 nights. Day 1: Departing from Morelia to Barra de Navidad (594 Km). Boat trip across Barra de Navidad Bay, continue trip to Chamela Biological Station (70 Km). Day 2: Walking the Chamela Biosphere Reserve. Day 3: Trip to Puerto Vallarta (157 Km), and tour around Banderas Bay and Marietas Islands (snorkeling and kayaking). Dinner at Puerto Vallarta. Day 4: Trip to Amatitán town (368 Km), visiting a Tequila Produce site, continue to Tlaquepaque town (56 Km) for dinner and shopping arts and crafts. Returning trip to Morelia (335 Km).
Transportation	Bus
Costs	600 USD Including, transportation, accommodation, meals and tours.
Form of Payment & Cancellation Policy	<u>To register and pay for the trip press HERE</u> . Any cancellation will have a penalty of 5% for bank fees. In case of having less than 15 registrants before June 30, the trip will be cancelled and money reimbursed to registrants at Morelia, taking 5 % for bank fees. Cancellations after June 30 will have a total deduction of \$ 250 USD as by this time bus reservations can not be cancelled and money can not be paid back. Registration and payment may be still possible at Morelia, but subject to availability. Please consider that paying in advance will help us to sense the feasibility of the trip.
